

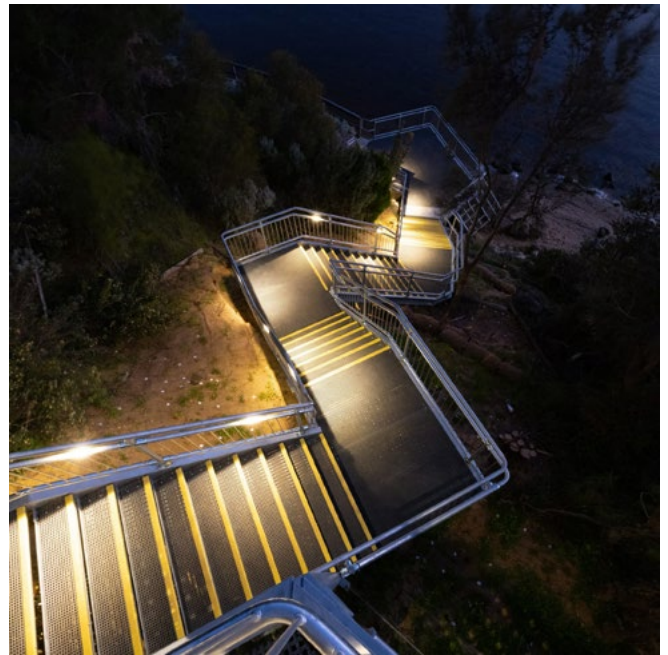
Four Trends in Elevating Outdoor Handrails and Balustrades

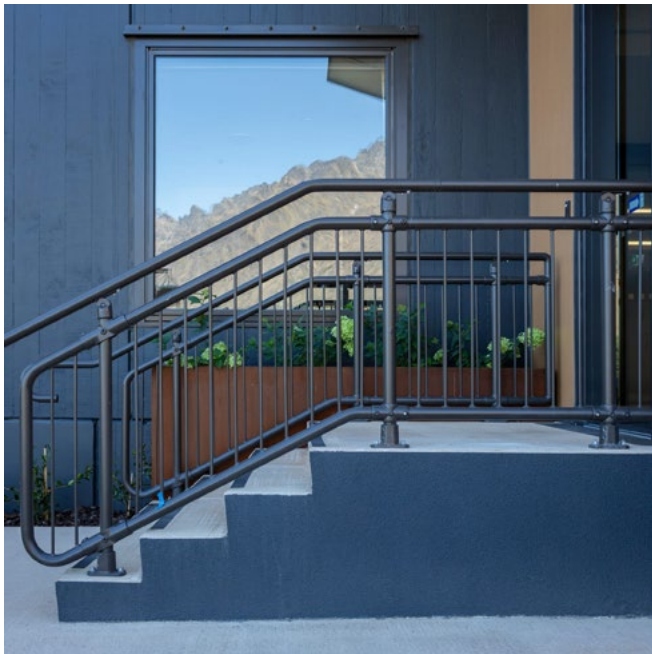
