FIPWA is a state-of-the-art agri-food innovation facility comprised of an Innovation Centre, Research and Development Centre, and Food and Beverage Production Centre. Complementing the exposed industrial elements of the building's interior and exterior, black powder-coated Conectabal® Commercial Balustrades were specified for multiple fire-exit egress/fire emergency stairs, inside the commercial office spaces and also on the balcony of which required in-house customisation to suit the pitched triangular design. Black powder-coated Assistrail® Disability Handrails (AR10) were also supplied for DDA compliance on an external stairway.


